COVID-19 cases will now be classified as either "confirmed" or "probable" based on the following criteria and definitions:

**Confirmed case:** The case meets the confirmed laboratory evidence, which is the detection of SARS-CoV2 RNA in a clinical specimen using an approved detection test verified by a certified testing laboratory.

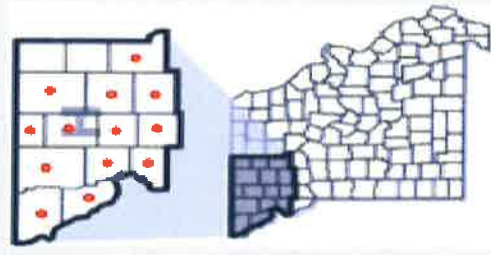
**Probable case:** The case meets clinical criteria AND epidemiologic evidence (close contact with a confirmed or probable case; travel to or residence in an area with sustained, ongoing community spread; or a member of a risk cohort as defined by public health authorities during an outbreak), with no confirmatory laboratory testing performed for COVID-19.

\*Probable cases will not be reflected on the DHSS website.

- 152,551 deaths



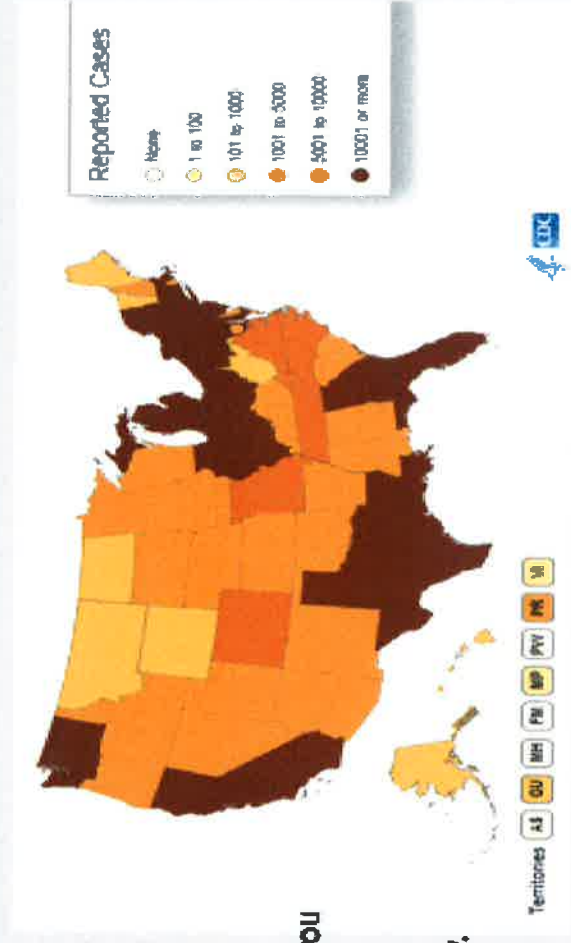
